Swiss-Snowboard needs new Snowboard freestyle judges for national and international competitions.

As a future judge you will be performing as a snowboard freestyle judge in Big Air, Halfpipe, Slopestyle and Rail competitions. You will be trained to be responsible to rank and score riders according to the FIS and WSF Rules. As a future Snowboard judge you should have a good trick knowledge and be very involved in our sport.

As a judge you can expect an interesting and responsible job where you can show that snowboarding is an important part of your life.

The beginners judge course will take place in Muri, Berne and will be held during one day on Saturday 21st of November 2020. After passing this course successfully you can join the day after on Sunday 22nd of November 2020 the national advanced Judges clinic. In your first judging season you already can expect to judge the first lower level competitions in Switzerland.
